





- 30-day deadline for submission of housing application forms; Maximum June 7, 2024;
- Selection of subsidized households;
- Housing allocation, July 2024;
- Confirmation letter sent to people who have been allocated housing; 7 days to respond;
- Receipt of the applicant's acceptance or rejection.

Allocation of Subsidized Housing

The allocation of subsidized housing is regulated by law and governed by the Société d'Habitation du Québec.

Subsidized housing is allocated on a point system;

By taking into consideration various criteria, the main ones being:

- the age of the application
- income level
- place of residence

The number of subsidized dwellings must be at least 50% but not more than 80% of the total number of dwellings in the building.

Timeline, continued...

- Invitation to a session to choose planned accommodation, date to be announced;
- Signing of leases, four (4) months prior to the arrival of the first resident;
- Hiring of staff;
- relocation planning;
- Completion of the work and arrival of the first residents.
